# KBIS Projects Continued Growth

**LAS VEGAS, NV** — Following last year’s 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary event, which saw more than 41,500 registered attendees and over 670 exhibitors, the Kitchen & Bath Industry Show is scheduled for February 25-27, 2025, once again located at the Las Vegas Convention Center in Las Vegas, NV. This year’s show is projected to host over 55,500 registered attendees.

Part of Design and Construction Week, KBIS will again be co-located with the International Builders’ Show. DCW features over 2,300 exhibitors and covers 1.2 million total net square feet, with 500,000 square feet dedicated to KBIS alone. The co-location is expected to host over 110,000 design and construction professionals.

“We are so proud of the community we’ve created at KBIS,” said Jason McGraw, group v.p., KBIS. “The success of this show is down to the leaders, creators, thinkers and innovators who attend and display at this event, and we’re inspired every year by what we see. Without fail, KBIS defies even the highest expectations we set, and we can’t wait to show the kitchen and bath industry all that’s in store for 2025.”

## SHOW HIGHLIGHTS

“It will be a challenge to surpass last year’s 60th-anniversary show, which was marked by an incredible display of expertise and enthusiasm,” said Bill Darcy, global president & CEO of NKBA | KBIS. “However, we are more than ready to meet that challenge. The 2025 show is set to deliver an inspirational standard of design and innovation from both exhibitors and attendees, with an even stronger international presence as KBIS

continues to connect the North American market with the global industry. With diverse perspectives, new opportunities, and increased expertise – alongside expanded digital opportunities and on-site events – KBIS 2025 will distinctly highlight the future of our dynamic industry.”

- Wednesday, Feb. 26 will open with the NKBA State of the Association from 8:30 a.m. to 10:15 a.m.
- The BASH at XS Nightclub at Encore will close the second night of KBIS and is scheduled to take place from 8:30 p.m. to 12:30 a.m., hosted by the NKBA.
- The IBS concert featuring country music star Chris Janson, taking place after the close of DCW on Thursday night.

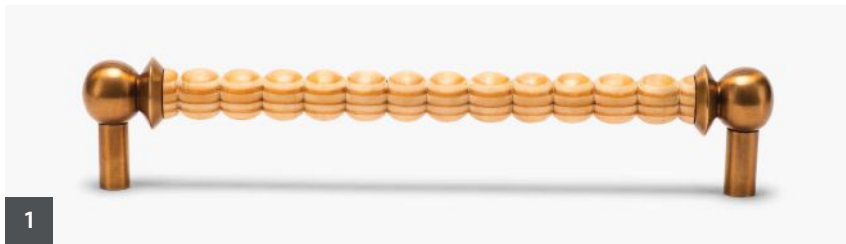
## EDUCATION & ACTIVITIES

The Voices from the Industry Conference at KBIS will provide educational sessions and workshops,

many of which offer continuing education units (CEUs). Over 70 educational sessions from Tuesday to Thursday – including three two-hour workshops, 51 one-hour workshops and 14 1.5-hour workshops – will offer attendees the chance to hear presentations from industry peers aligned to one of six tracks: Building & Remodeling, Leadership & Management, Design, K&B Trends, Hot Topics and Marketing.

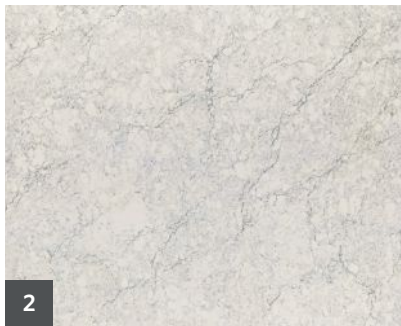
Education and information will also be provided through a variety of channels at the show, including:

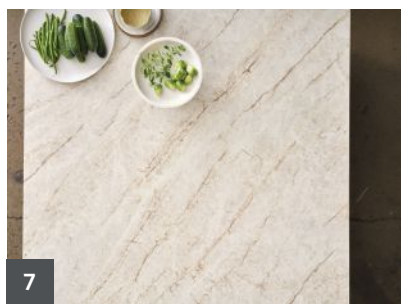

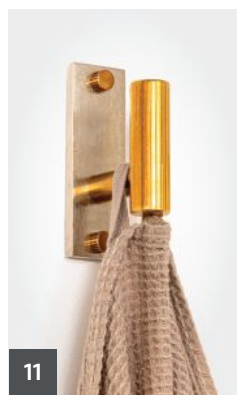
