


INSTALLATION GUIDE

- 1. Use a pipe wrench to loosen and remove the old basket strainer. If there's a disposal unit, disconnect it from the old strainer as well.
- 2. Pull out the basket, and look down inside the strainer. You will see a screw. Unscrew it using a coin or flat head screwdriver to disassemble the drain. [Fig. 1]



- 3. Attach the drain to the sink as shown. [Fig 2]
- 4. The Black Rubber Gasket goes below the sink. Make sure ribbed side is up.

- 5. Tighten the screw with a screw driver or coin to secure the drain assembly to the sink.
- 6. Turn on the water supply and check for any leaks. If you notice any leaks, try tightening the connections or adding plumber's tape.
