THE KITCHEN & BATH INDUSTRY SHOW (KBIS), held recently in Las Vegas, welcomed an enthusiastic crowd of industry professionals excited to learn about the latest products and trends in kitchen and bath design. KBIS, sponsored by the National Kitchen & Bath Association, was one of five shows folded into Design & Construction Week, which also included the International Builders Show (IBS).

The combined five trade shows gave attendees an amazing opportunity to visit five industry trade events with only one badge. Total attendance was nearly 70,000 at IBS and 40,000 at KBIS, with more than 1,800 exhibitors showcasing the latest housing products stretched across almost 1 million net square feet of exhibit space.

Highlights from the brands exhibiting included wellness products, personalized options, new finishes and, above all — color! Here are a few standouts:

Orange Sensation

Cartisan Design's colorful display included its new Sebastian and Barcelona vanities. The Sebastian has a beautiful shape and stunning red-amber color, in contrast with its dark walnut wooden legs. This outstanding design sets it apart from other vanities — modern and artistic. Two drawers provide comfortable storage space. Pure white countertops with white vessel sinks

bring a sense of freshness and cleanliness to the entire bath space.

Also on display was the newest model Barcelona. This vanity brings elegance, texture and clean lines to your client's bathing space. Barcelona features two sturdy undermount-style sinks, as well as ample storage space for all bath necessities. Both are made from multilayered engineering wood for durability.

Haute Couture for the Bath
